## FINISHED Sherry Butt

100% Blue Agave grown and harvested in the Highlands.

The Tequila is an extra aged Anejo, aged in Bourbon barrels for 2+ years and then finished in Oloroso Sherry Butts.

The spicy notes of the bourbon are well balanced with the sweet sherry flavors, integrating with the wood beautifully.

The agave is always present. An exceptional array of flavors roll out a perfect bell curve from start to finish.

The bottle was hand sculpted in paper mache by Bonnie Lopez and then replicated in clay to ultimately produce the bottle you see.
